

Honduras Mission Trip
July 13-20, 2009
General Information

Purpose of Trip – To take the word of Jesus to an unsaved nation. We will be doing modified VBS in the local schools, street evangelism, drama, puppets to name a few.

Training – Is mandatory for all going on the trip. Training will be on Tuesday evenings, 6:00-9:00pm for 6 weeks, beginning May 5th in the Youth Room.

Cost of trip - \$1300 (students pay \$800, money budgeted for difference)

Location – La Ceiba, Honduras (3rd largest city in Honduras) – 300,000 people
This is a modern city with a mall and food places such as Pizza Hut & Burger King. Bottled water will be provided. Do not drink any water not from a bottle and do not eat any raw vegetables or fruits that have been washed in the local water. Also, do not buy any food from the local street vendors. We will be staying in a hotel that World Hope uses (exact hotel not confirmed yet, there are 3 they use). Our goal is 3 people per room, including one adult in each room).

Baggage – 1 checked piece per person and 1 carry on per person.

Arrival – Passport required. When going through customs, you will be photographed & fingerprinted. A temporary VISA will be issued at customs.

Local Transportation – We will be met at the airport in San Pedro Sula by the local contact, Pastor Jorge Note. He will be our guide for the week. Transportation from San Pedro Sula to La Ceiba and for the week will be by big yellow school bus. The trip from the airport to the hotel will be about 3 ½ hours, through old banana and pineapple plantations.

Dress – Females, your knees cannot show. Capri pants are fine. For Sunday a dress or skirt/top (again, below knees) will be needed. Males, pants or jeans for the week and the same for Sunday with a pull-over collared shirt. No tank tops, muscle shirts, halters, spaghetti strap shirts or shorts for anyone. The Honduran people dress their best for Sunday services, which are in the evening. Girls – fanny packs are strongly suggested or a sling purse. Guys – money belts are the suggestion for you.

Passport – Please two copies of your passport. Leave one at home and leave one your suitcase in the hotel. Carry your passport on you at all times.

Money – We will wire money to Pastor Jorge and he will get it exchanged into the local currency before we arrive. Take very little cash as American money will not be widely accepted. Your meals and snacks are covered in the cost of the trip.

Medical – You need to have a current Tetanus shot and also a current Hepatitis A vaccine. You will also need to be taking Malaria medicine. Please see your family doctor.

Vision Trip – Matt Parker, Scott Patterson & a World Hope representative are traveling to La Ceiba May 23-25 to see the location, hotel, visit the schools, churches, etc.
